MAKE SURE EVERY SIGNATURE COUNTS!

Follow the easy instructions on the reverse side, and double-check these important points:

- ✓ **One county per petition.** Above the signature spaces, you'll see a space to write in the name of the county. Everyone who signs this petition must reside in that county. Use a separate petition for each county. (It doesn't matter where you, the circulator, reside.)

- ✓ **Only registered voters may sign.** Any eligible California resident who would like to register to vote may do so online at RegisterToVote.ca.gov and then sign the petition. (Blue or black ink!)

- ✓ **Voters must fill out their information themselves, and must use their residential address.** Street addresses only, no P.O. boxes or work addresses.

- ✓ **Don't forget to fill out the "Declaration of Circulator" section.** After collecting signatures, fill out and sign the "circulator" section in your own handwriting.

**VOLUNTEER
PETITION CIRCULATOR
INSTRUCTIONS**

- Petition circulators must be at least 18 years of age or older. Petition circulators are not required to be California residents and are not required to be registered to vote.
- Circulators must **personally witness** each signature being appended to the petition – circulators cannot leave a petition on a table unattended.
- Only voters registered to vote in the same county can sign on the numbered lines of each petition section. Circulators who are registered to vote in that same county may also sign on the numbered lines. Duplicate signers and non-registered or out-of-jurisdiction voters can jeopardize qualification of the measure. A circulator may carry multiple petition sections for different counties.
- Each voter signing the petition must complete all information with her or her own hand and must not be assisted by the circulator.

- Petition circulator must completely fill out the "Declaration of Circulator" after collecting the signatures on each petition section. Incomplete declarations may result in rejection of all of the signatures on the petition section. The information must be filled out in the circulator's own hand and information cannot be pre-printed.

- It is a misdemeanor under the California Elections Code to allow signatures on a petition to be used *for any purpose other than* qualification of the measure for the ballot.
- At all times, circulator must circulate the complete petition. Pages cannot be circulated separately and signature pages cannot be added.
- Circulator shall not:
 - Misrepresent or make a false statement concerning the contents, purport or effect of the measure
 - Refuse to allow a prospective signer to read the petition
 - Cover or obscure the Title and Summary from the view of a prospective signer
 - Give money or any other item of value to another person in exchange for his or her signature
 - Forge signatures or provide false or fictitious information
 - Refuse to surrender petitions to the proponent / supervisor in charge of signature gathering
